MAKE SOME SOUND

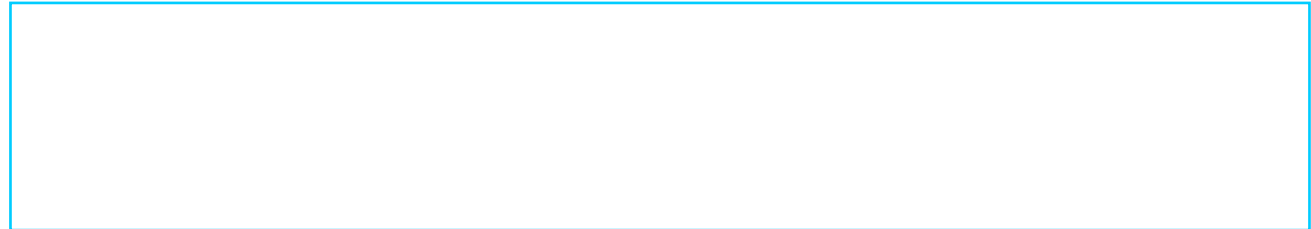
