



#### THE FACILITY

Monona Terrace is a convention center like no other, stretching 90 feet over the shimmering waters of Lake Monona, designed by world-renowned architect Frank Lloyd Wright, and just two blocks from the State Capitol in one of America's most welcoming cities, Madison, Wisconsin.

Spanning 250,000 square feet, this multilevel convention center is surrounded by curving, geometric forms that converge with the breathtaking beauty of the natural environment. Spectacular glass vistas enhance the flexible meeting and exhibition spaces, inviting the beauty of the outdoors into every event.

- Ballroom designed to accommodate more than 1,000 diners beneath beautiful chandeliers.
- Multimedia lecture hall amply seats 300 theater-style and is fully equipped with cutting-edge technology.
- Meeting spaces offering a multitude of flexible spaces ranging in size.
- Exhibit hall featuring 37,200 flexible square feet of essential convention amenities, including a show manager office, concession areas, seven loading bays, and a truck wash bay.
- Expansive Rooftop Garden is our facility's 68,000-square-foot crown jewel overlooking the lake that complements and celebrates Madison's vibrant cityscape, providing a stunning backdrop for any event.
- Pre-function space devoted to public space for registration, receptions, or breaks, including the mezzanine and its two executive boardrooms.

#### **ROOM CAPACITIES**

**Telecommunications:** The building is wired with advanced cabling and fiber optic lines to support seamless hyper-speed internet connectivity. Complimentary wireless internet access is available across the entire building, including the rooftop gardens.

**Lighting:** Custom lighting presets can be programmed for any meeting space in the building. Meeting rooms and the Exhibition Hall feature energy-efficient LED lighting and adjustable incandescent lights. For theatrical lighting needs, our lighting specialists are available to assist and ensure your event shines.

**Sound:** Our facility is equipped with a comprehensive public address system that ensures premium sound quality throughout. With a range of mixers and a professional stereo system operated by a dedicated technician, we can ensure exceptional quality for all of your audio needs.

Video: Informational displays at kiosks and room entrances keep attendees updated with real-time event information. A separate system facilitates video displays in overflow rooms and allows for seamless broadcasting. Any room can be equipped for livestream events. We also provide a range of video projectors compatible with computers of various HD resolutions and screen sizes.

**Staging/Platforms:** Portable stages and risers are available for use throughout our venue, while our Lecture Hall includes a fixed stateof-the-art stage perfect for performing arts, formal lectures, guest speakers, and countless other functions suitable to your imagination.

**Equipment:** In-house inventory is equipped with microphones, portable sound and lighting, projection equipment, video cameras, screens, tables, chairs, skirting, dance floors, lecterns, pianos, ADA ramps, and more.




#### **Getting to Monona Terrace**

Getting to Monona Terrace is easy, with multiple transportation options. Drivers can take advantage of the Monona Terrace Parking Garage on W. Wilson St. for direct access to the convention center. In addition, street parking and public lots are available throughout downtown Madison.

- Multiple <u>electric bike stations</u> and <u>Madison Metro bus</u> <u>stops</u> are just a short walk from Monona Terrace.














## FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT

#### The Vision

Frank Lloyd Wright originally proposed a design for the Monona Terrace Community and Convention Center in 1938. He eschewed the traditional Victorian ornamentation and classical design trends of the time and embraced a purer architectural expression, characterized by geometric forms, open floor plans, and low-hipped roofs that harmonized with the landscape. He imagined a bold curvilinear gathering place intended to connect the shores of Lake Monona to the State Capitol. While the design was revised many times, its signature curves remained a defining feature. Today, Monona Terrace blends Wright's timeless vision with cutting-edge technology and modern amenities, creating a space that continues to inspire and bring people together.
